In regards to media report of Dominion's "airgap" making hacking physically impossible, e.g.,

Dominion's tabulators do not have exposed USB or other memory ports.

First, a computer system has to have some way to transfer data, in and out, and also update the operating system voting software for patches and installing the OS itself.

Second, the local results have to be *tabulated* with all the other voting precincts. That means there has to be an Internet connection to a central server to *add up all the votes* (which also allows possible manipulate of the votes.)

Thus, all Computerized Voting Systems have to have some connection to a network via Ethernet, USB, Wireless, etc.
