Electoral College = House Of Representatives, Not The Senate

Electoral College is like the House of Representatives, not The Senate. More Populated states like New York and California get way more Electoral Votes then those in rural areas.

For example, geographically smaller but larger population-wise New Jersey gets like fourteen (14) votes, while Alaska only gets a minimum of three (3).

The reason it's a minimum of three (3) for Alaska is that two (2) of the electoral votes are because there are a minimum of two (2) senators and the other one (1) is the US representative.

The Total Electoral Votes are the sum of both the Senate (100) and the US House of Representatives (435), and as you can see, the House of Representatives has more than four (4) times the electoral votes than the Senate, plus big states also get their two (2) Senate Electoral Votes.

Hence, Electoral College is not racist and very reflective of the popular vote.
