Psalm 110°1 Annotated

The 1st LORD, shown in All Caps, is God-The <u>Father</u> (Adon<u>ai</u> in Hebrew)

The LORD said to my Lord, Messiah or J "Sit at My right hand, (Adon<u>i</u> in Heb Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"

The 2nd Lord, in Proper Case, is God-The Son, The Messiah or Jesus (Adon<u>i</u> in Hebrew)

This means Jesus Christ ascended into Heaven and sits at the Right Hand of God-The Father, and does not go back to Earth until God-The Father puts the Messiah's Enemies into a very weakened position. Thus, The Second Coming of Jesus Christ will come AFTER God-The Father deals with Jesus' Enemies. ...Yet, who are Jesus' Enemies?

MORE NOTES: #1- How can the 2nd Lord mentioned also sit at the Right Hand of God and be just a Man and not be divine and sinless? #2 - Jesus (in Matthew 22) asked how can King David call the Messiah "Lord" (or master, even if human) when the Messiah is supposed to an offspring of King David? #3 - The Son of God is not the same as God (i.e., God the Father, Adonai). And sitting at the "right hand" of God is not the same as sitting on the main throne where God sits. Hence, the 2nd Lord (Adoni) is correct as Jesus was also a Man and died on the cross, and thus, not a translation error as Judaism argues.
