That Same Question for -Matthew 22: 41-46 NKJV The Jews

While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, saying, "What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?" They said to Him, "The Son of David." He said to them, "How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying:

Christ, meaning The Messiah or The Anointed The 1st LORD, shown in All Caps, is God-The Father

Proper Case, is God-The Son, The Messiah or Jesus

Psalm 110:1

The LORD said to my Lord,
"Sit at My right hand,
Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" '?

If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?" And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.

*In other words, Psalm 110:1 (Scripture) shows that the Messiah, i.e., Christ, is not 100% human (i.e., Son of David) as The Jews (Judaism) believe, but also The Son of God (divine).
