While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, saying, *"What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?"* They said to Him, *"The Son of David."* He said to them, *"How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying:*

Christ, meaning
The Messiah or
The Anointed

The 1st LORD,
shown in All Caps,
is God-The Father

The 2nd Lord, in
Proper Case, is
God-The Son, The
Messiah or Jesus

Psalm 110:1

**The LORD said to my Lord,
"Sit at My right hand,
Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" '?**

If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?" And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.

*** In other words, Psalm 110:1 (Scripture) shows that the Messiah, i.e., Christ, is not 100% human (i.e., Son of David) as The Jews (Judaism) believe, but also The Son of God (divine).**
