A TRIPPED GOING INTO ELEVATOR OR BURNS DOWN PARTS OF TOWN

1921 TULSA RIOT STORY OF ELEVATOR SOUNDS FAR-FETCHED...

Black Delivery Boy trips and grabs White Woman's Arm in Elevator to break fall? The 1921 Tulsa Riot has a truly amazing amount of detail about an incident in an elevator. Yet, there is essentially zero about the businesses that made up Black Wall Street. That is nothing about them from the product or services sold, or even the names of these businesses.

Next, if Oklahoma was so segregated, why would a Black man (even a Black delivery boy) be anywhere near a Whites-Only area? Didn't Whites have their own White Delivery Boys? That is, why would a White person in a Whites-Only building order something from a Black-Owned Business? And vice-versa. In other words, this is Black Wall Street, correct? Thus, Blacks and Black Delivery Boys were too busy working for Blacks-Only Greenwood. So Option A (Tripping Going into Elevator...Starts Riot), seems far-fetched as Blacks and Whites were always segregated to begin with. But it's great for Hollywood movies, TV Ratings, and getting grants and donations fueled by White Guilt.
